Mary Ellen Hopkins Piecing Techniques #2

Instructor – Dianne Jansson

This is the second level of the Mary Ellen workshops. Adding triangles gives you a whole new range of patterns to work with. Several methods for perfectly piecing triangles (PPT's) will be covered. Try them all and decide which method works best for you. Sometimes the patterns or design will dictate the best method to use.

You may choose to work on one project, or several smaller ones giving a chance to try more techniques. As usual, for a Mary Ellen Hopkins workshop it is best to bring a whole collection of fabric and make final choices in class

Fabric:

Many of the projects in this workshop are made up of four fabrics

#1 main print – 2m

#2 background – 2/3 m can be scrappy

#3 & 4 at least two contrast fabrics that work with you main choice/more is better - .75 m

If you plan to sew samples, a collection of fat quarters will work.

General supplies to bring::

- Machine and regular sewing supplies
- Extension cord
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Smaller square ruler (4, 6, 8")
- Quarter square and half square ruler – optional
- Setting triangle or side set ruler – optional
- Graph paper and colour pencils
- Neutral thread
- Power bar and extension cord
