

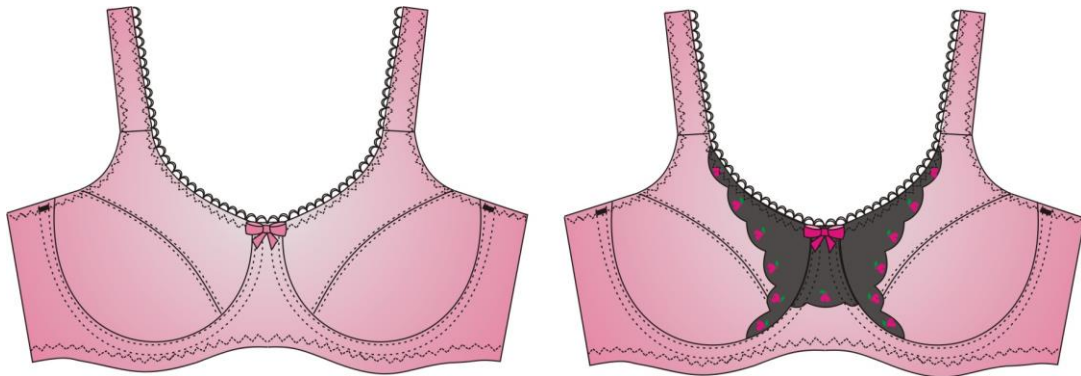


**Saskatchewan
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Beginner Bra Class

If you are into precision sewing and are looking for a bit of a challenge or desire to make a bra that is custom fitted to your body, then this is a class you will enjoy. You will be sewing a **basic full band bra**, (with or without underwires) and fine tuning the fit so that you end up with Beverly's own pattern for a perfect-fitting bra. Once you have a basic bra that fits, you can make a second bra using lace to really strengthen your bra-making skills. **A specialized class for those with intermediate sewing skills.**



Please have the following supplies on hand:

- Rotary cutter and mat, weights optional (if you use rotary cutters)
- Paper Scissors, SHARP fabric scissors, thread snips
- Stretch 75/11 machine needles
- 1/4" foot or a foot to ensure a perfect 1/4" seam allowance.
- Topstitching foot or a stitch-in-the-ditch foot
- Regular polyester thread white
- Blue Washout marker
- Drafting paper, scotch tape to make revisions to the pattern
- Zig-zag sewing machine in good working order and its power cords/foot pedal
- Basic sewing supplies including spare bobbins, a seam ripper, pins, tape measure, extra needles, seam gauge etc
- Iron and Ironing board
- Optional: Walking foot and pressing ham.

The instructor will be in contact with you prior to April 15 regarding kit colours and sizing.
