SUPPLY LIST

- 2 2" strips for binding
- 14" x 15" approx. for backing
- 14" x 15" approx. batting of choice
- Pellon fusible interfacing I use and suggest Pellon 911FF 13" x 15"

Fabric:

Note: The fabric sizes given below are the size of the pieces needed to cut the shapes out of and what's included in the kit. No need to cut them before-hand as you can use yardage or fat quarters. It just gives you an idea of how large a piece of fabric you will need. Use the color photo as a guide with the pattern sheet

- A1 3" x 5" light yellow
- A2 3.5" x 5" medium yellow
- A3 7" x 4.5" dark yellow / yellow-orange
- A4 6" x 7" red
- A5 6.5" x 2.5" red
- A6 9" x 7" red
- A7 + D1 12 ¼" x 6" background Teal in my sample
- B1 3" x 4" light green
- B2 + B3 4.5" x 5.5" darker green
- C1 2" x 3" brown
- C2 4" x 5" background Teal in my sample
- E1 7" x 4" background Teal in my sample
- E2 10" x 5" background Teal in my sample
- E3 10" x 6" background Teal in my sample
- E4 11" x 3.5" background Teal in my sample
- E5 9 ¼" x 6" background Teal in my sample
- F1 10" x 2" gray in my sample
- F2 13" x 3.5" black in my sample
- Thread for piecing to match your fabrics
- Thread for quilting



- Iron and ironing board
- Parchment paper
- A pencil or fine permanent marker or any other tool to mark the fusible interfacing
- Sewing machine with a zigzag foot
- Small glue stick or fabric glue stick
- Thread snips or small scissors
- A copy of each pattern on 11" x 17" paper
