(put your name on everything if you can)

Old clothes to wear, apron, rubber gloves

Dust mask

2 Table sized pieces of plastic

Bucket (at least one, two better)

1 – 3 Sponges

Old towels, cut apart to hand-towel size

Small paint roller, large paint roller

1 – 2 Squeegees (like a window squeegee), or 1 – 2 plastic putty knives 2” – 4”, or old credit cards (optional)

About six spatulas, stirring sticks or spoons – something to stir the dye with

Roll of blue masking tape

Roll Duct tape for taping silkscreens

Two sharpie markers

2 – 4 Brushes, like foam, optional 2 – 4 cheap hair paintbrushes

6-10 Yogurt or plastic food containers with lids (quart size is best), but half quart is fine, too.

1 – 4 squirt bottles (like ketchup bottle)

Scissors to cut sponges and cloth

Notebook, pencil/pen

Camera, phone camera, or something to remember processes!

Things for stamping and printing: Stencils, cutouts, lace, sticks, skewers, chopsticks, machine gears or washers, plastic things like bottle caps or coasters, pool noodle. Don't buy anything, just look for objects that are slightly raised surface. One of my favorites is plastic place mats!

Silk screens (1-3) 18” X 24” We will have some for use in class and for sale.



Saskatchewan Stitches Conference

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Fabric: 10 yards minimum, cut in ½ to 1 yard pieces (feel free to bring more like 10-20 yards) of pfd 100% cotton, I use Test Fabrics #419 or #400M. **Note: we will be ordering in the Test fabric that Pat uses, if you would like to purchase some please order from Haus of Stitches 1-800-344-6024 before April 1 or as soon as possible.**
Cost of the fabric is \$15.99/m

. (You can also use predyed fabrics, and commercial prints. Just make sure that they are 100% cotton, and prewashed to remove the finishing materials added to the fabric). May also soda soak ahead other cotton, linen, lightweight canvas, predyed cottons for experimentation.

Sew tags to your fabric with tyvek (old US mail envelopes, add in sharpie marker your first name, last initial) before soda soaking. Make sure you have soda soaked and dried the material ahead of time. (soda soak formula: one scant gallon water to one cup sodium carbonate (soda ash), add fabric loosely to solution to soak 15 minutes, ring out, hang to dry, do not dry in dryer)

If you do not have soda ash to do this it can be done at the beginning of class but please let us know if you will need to do this
