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Supply List

Nuno Felting

Instructor: Heather Grover

Please bring the following items to class:

1 pkg of painters plastic drop cloth
1 piece of bubble wrap about 2 feet long (small bubbles)
1 bar of either olive oil or goats milk soap (at bulk barn store)
1 felting net (allength of lace curtain, mosquito netting or tulle - little bigger than your scarf) check out thrift stores.
4 old bath towels. You may need to cut one.
Old tights or a tee shirt that will be cut into 18'' strips bowl
sprinkler for felting (recommend a ball brause) scissors

a loose weave scarf about 18'' x 70'' can be cotton, viscose, polyester.

I like to use scarves with interesting patterns like stripes.(find in thrift stores)

200 grams of merino wool, 19.5 microns (no higher than 21 microns) in a colour to compliment the scarf. You may choose more than 1 colour or use a variegated roving.

A good supplier is Legacy Studio in Cochrane Alberta. She is on line and can custom dye if you need special colour. She also has Silk ,Tencel, Bamboo fibres and silk hankies if you would like to add some to your scarf but that is optional embellishing fibres.

Interesting yarns, coloured cheese cloth are also great for embellishing and optional.
