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## Supply List

### Texturing Techniques

**Instructor:** Bonny Voice

This is a class in which you will be exploring different ways of building texture into your fabric. The goal of this class is for you to create samples that you can use as a reference when you do other projects. Given time restraints, many samples will be unfinished and less than perfect .

- Sewing machine in good working order, with manual
- Bobbins. Make sure you have several
- Bring all your accessories, including the free motion foot, open toe foot, zipper foot
- Basic sewing supplies
- Basic quilting supplies
- Spritzer bottle for water
- 2 baking cooling racks
- Sewing machine needles, including jean or universal needles size 80/12 or 90/14 and embroidery needles size 90/14. If you are bringing decorative threads, be sure to bring needles that work with them, For example, metallic threads require metallic needles
- Twin needle. If you have one at home, bring it. If you are purchasing one, get an embroidery twin needle- needle distance 2.0 mm, needle size NM 75(schmetz)
- Thread for stitching. Good quality cotton thread that is a slight contrast to fabric. Also bring any decorative threads you want to try-remember to bring the complementary needle. I will have some there for your use
- 2 meters fabric. Cut eight 10" squares and bring the rest of the yardage uncut. I recommend cotton muslin that has a soft hand. Prewashed is best. You can bring pieces of fabric from home if you want. It should be soft. A high thread count is not necessary
- .2m of lightweight iron on interfacing, if narrow, less if wide width
- Water soluble stabilizer. Bring what you have from home or purchase a package
- Optional, but helpful: teflon sheet
- Threads and yarns for couching. I will also have a good supply of couching thread/yarns for class use
- If you have sheers, old scarves bring them along. I will also have some for class use
- Small pieces of batting
- Optional: if you have powder adhesive, bring it with you. I also have some for class use
- Texture magic. You don't need much for class, approximately 10" square, and so if you want to share with a friend, please do so
- Embroidery frame that can be used with your machine
