Mary Ellen Hopkins Piecing Techniques #3

Instructor – Dianne Jansson

Much of the third level of the Mary Ellen Hopkins workshops focuses on sixty degree piecing. this is not fast machine piecing but more intricate work - you will be back to using lots of pins. Many of the designs create 3D effects by using, light, medium and dark colour values. Remember this is a technique class and there is not a set patterns. You will gain most from the workshop by sewing samples of the various designs using 60 degrees. This also reduces the stress of choosing fabrics ahead of time. On the second day you will have more time to design and sew a small quilt.

The projects are not large, so you will not require large amounts of fabric - but the more variety you bring, the more creative your choices can be. As with the other workshops, you will receive many pages of design ideas, and will see a variety of samples before you have to make your choices.

Supplies:

Machine and regular sewing supplies

Extension cord and power bar

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

At least 1 ruler must have a sixty degree angle

Optional - Quilters Quarter Marker ruler

Pencil and paper

1 M of background fabric

2 or 3 sets of fabric that co-ordinate - with light, medium and dark values in each set

.25m each should be ample

A container of straps to use for highlights
