All entries will be exhibited at the 2022 Saskatchewan Stitches Conference and a possible winner's exhibit at the Humboldt and District Museum and Gallery.

The entries will be judged based on creativity, inspiration, technique, and workmanship in categories listed as well as for the overall challenge. We have many great prizes lined up including a Janome 3160 QOV- C, an Elna Lotus 2 and a Bernina 335, and much more.

- ✓ Participants must have attended at least one Saskatchewan Stitches
 - Conference (on site or virtually) or been registered for the 2020 event.
- ✓ If possible, send a photo of the project before you started.
- ✓ Write a short story about your project to be displayed with your entry!
- Project and completed entry form must be received by the Haus of Stitches no later than 6:00 pm, May 1, 2022.
