Supply List

Scrap Quilts - Working with Value

Instructor: Dianne Jansson

FABRIC

You will need a large collection of prints (no solids or white on white) and tone on tone fabrics in a range of light, medium and dark values. There are always many mediums, but you will have to work on the lights and good rich deep darks. I would suggest at least 100 fabrics - more is better. You will be amazed at just how many you have in your stash. If necessary, beg or steal from friends. Carefully cut at least two 4" square from each fabric. Cut diagonally in half and get 2 triangles from each square. From these triangles, make up 5 plastic sandwich bags with a selection of 20 triangles in each - the rest are for yourself. The 5 bags will be for a class swap where you will receive 5 different bags. This will give you more variety to work with, and ensure that you are not just working in your favorite colour palette. I will bring a few challenge triangles for everyone.

Supplies:

Design Board or flannel - approximately 30 x 40"
tray, Rubbermaid container lid or pizza box to carry pieces to your design area
pins
Reducing glass, peeper, or value finder - camera also works

If you plan to start sewing

machine and regular sewing equipment
Rotary cutter, ruler and small mat
4" x 6" square ruler
